## Categories (\$400 prizes)

1. Open Colour -1<sup>st</sup> prize \$400
2. Creative Photography- artistic or digitally enhanced - 1<sup>st</sup> prize \$400
3. Monochromatic photography - images using only one main colour - 1<sup>st</sup> prize \$400
4. 12 years & under Photography – 1<sup>st</sup> prize a Digital Camera
5. Digital delivery - images sent by email...details will follow in the conditions below - 1<sup>st</sup> prize \$400

## Additional Prizes

Best work (any category) depicting the Special York Theme of “Avon River Alive”- \$500

Viewer’s choice adult (any category) - \$200

Viewer’s choice 12 years & under - \$50

## Explanation of York Subject Theme

“Avon River Alive” may depict flora and/or fauna or movement of the river. Your interpretation of the theme may be explained to us in a sentence of 25 words or less if you wish. This interpretive sentence may be displayed with your work for the interest of the judges and public.

## York Photographic Awards

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR FRAMED WORKS

1. All entries to be made online via [www.theyorksociety.com](http://www.theyorksociety.com)
2. All work must be entrants OWN UNAIDED AND ORIGINAL WORK and not previously exhibited in the Avon Valley. Any works found not to be completely original will be ineligible for a prize.
3. Entries are limited to four (4) photographs per person. This also applies to 12 & under who may also enter adult categories. No one photograph may be entered into more than 1 category. Diptychs separately framed count as 2 works.
4. Entrants must be current residents of Western Australia.
5. The visible area of photographs themselves must not be less than 280sq.cm in total area (e.g. 15cm x 20cm mounted) and must be ready to hang with secure fittings and wire or cord. A \$10.00 fee per work will be levied at delivery if a wire /cord needs to be added. The work must not exceed 900mm in either dimension, including frame if present. Works must be suitably presented to exhibition standard (card mounting alone is not acceptable)
6. All works must be delivered clearly labelled on the rear bottom left hand corner using I.D forms to be downloaded from this website.
7. Any changes to titles or prices should be communicated to us by 27th March 2023.
8. It is desirable, though not obligatory, that all works, except those entered by entrants aged 18 and under, should be for sale. A commission of 25% will be charged on the GST exclusive price of all sales. (Note: Photographer’s asking price must include commission and GST if applicable.)
9. The Committee reserves the right to reject or reclassify any entry. Entry fees are not refundable. Late entries will only be accepted at the discretion of the Arts Coordinator.

## 10. Conditions of entry for New Digital Delivery Category

Theme for this Category only is "Birds in Flight"

Photographers entering works in this category need to email their images to us "Attention the York Photographic Awards Judging panel" by 5pm on the 12<sup>th</sup> March 2023. An entry via our website needs to be completed prior to you emailing the image.

It is a firm requirement that the properties of your images be submitted at the time of entry and that you state in your email that you give permission for the York Society to print/display and sell your image/s.

Images emailed must be a minimum of 3MB and a maximum of 8MB.

Works in this category will be shortlisted by our judges and only the shortlisted photographs will be printed and mounted for exhibition. The shortlisted works will be available for sale to the public and if sold the photographer will receive \$75. The sale price for these framed works will be determined by the York Society and will be to cover the costs of framing and printing plus giving a fair return to the photographer.

Works not selected to the shortlist may be displayed as a slideshow and may also be available for sale.

Entry fee for this category is \$30.

### **Entries close 5pm, 12th March 2023.**

11. The judging panel will view all entries received. The organisers reserve the right to select works for exhibition and some works may possibly not be exhibited. If, in the judges' opinion, there is no entry of an adequate standard in a section, they may refrain from making an award. The judges' decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into. Awarding of prizes is at the judges' discretion. There must be at least 3 entries into a category for an award to be granted. If a category has less than three entries those entries will be exhibited and made available for sale but will not be judged and no award will be given.

Winners and sellers will be contacted after the awards for their bank details.

12. Exhibitors are responsible for their own insurance. No liability is accepted for any loss or damage at depots or during transit. The York Society will take all reasonable care during the Exhibition but accepts no responsibility for damage to works while they are in the custody of the Society or its agents.

13. All proceeds from the sale of works will be processed within 35 days of the Exhibition.

14. The Committee reserves the right to allow any works entered to be reproduced in any medium for the purpose of promotion or publication.

15. LAW: All entries must comply with Australian Law; this is the full responsibility of the photographer. The laws will include Copyright, Indigenous and Cultural Law and Local, State and Federal Law.
